HOMAGE TO OUR FOUNDER



Late Anurupa Mukherjee is well known as pioneer Social Activist in the State of Tripura. Her main concern was to uplift educational and economical status of the tribal women in hilly and remote areas. The concept of running coaching centre for tribal girls, dropped out in Madhyamik Examination was initiated in the State by herself only. Formation and nurturing of Self Help group for Tribal men and women was initiated by the Samity in the year 1995 for social and economic empowerment of Tribal families.

Decades of self less work for the down trodden people particularly the women in remote areas has made her a a mother figure. Among the tribals, she was called as 'MAANI' which means Mother. Upliftment of educational and economical status of tribal women in hilly and remote areas was her main concern.

Decades have passed since she is no more with us, but we always feel her existence in every decision we make regarding implementation of projects for the deserted, homeless, tortured woman. We also provid shelter, education food and medicine to a child who needs such amenities.

We have strong belief in our mind that, her blessings will be always with us and we will continue to follow her directions, teachings in our every steps.



PREFACE

Tripura Adibashi Mahila Samity is continuing it's services for the welfare of needy people particularly the Women and Children since last 7 decades. Starting from working in slum areas of Agartala city by opening Night school for illiterate women, the organisation gradually stepped forward in villages and remote tribal areas and started opening literacy centres and weaving units. These experiences have helped us to feel the necessity and demands of local people and proposals were submitted to the State and Central Govt for financial assistance.

'Women Empowerment' is our main concern and we believe that without education no empowerment can be achieved and similarly, without economic empowerment, women remain suppressed in the family and she has no voice in decision making. In educational sector ,we have implemented or implementing various projects like Back to school project for school drop outs, Non Formal Education centres in tribal areas, Residential Coaching centres for unsuccessful tribal girls in Madhyamik Exam, , Secondary level Residential School for tribal girls etc. For economic empowerment, different vocational trainings have been organized by the Samity at Govt or Non Govt level. Hundreds of village women or unemployed ladies have started their own Tailoring shops, beauty parlour, fast food shops, working as care taker for Sr citizens or child.





Mission:-

The mission of the Tripura Adibashi Mahila Samity is to assist the tribal population preferably the tribal girls, women on education, income generation and building their capacity to have sustainable livelihoods.

It further includes it's dedicated service for organizing all categories of women population of the state and towards shouldering responsibilities of executing various developmental programmes especially designed for women population of Tripura

Vision:-

The vision of the Tripura Adibashi Mahila Samity is to create opportunities for overall development of the tribal population and especially for the tribal women of Tripura. As women based development Institute, the Samity maintain balance approach for its development initiatives on gender issues, women Empowerment and towards ensuring sustainable development of the tribal women of Tripura.



REPORT ON PROJECTS

1. RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL FOR TRIBAL GIRLS (Secondary):(Sponsored by Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt of India):-

Since inception of the Organization, Late Anurupa Mukherjee was keen about providing educational facilities for Girls and Women from interior areas of the State or from the slum areas nearby Agartala town. In 2008, a project of running Residential School for 100 tribal girls was sanctioned by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt of India. The school is named as Anurupa Academy in the name of Late Anurupa Mukherjee, founder President of the Organisation. It started its functioning at Pragati Road, Krishnanagar, Agaratala. This Institution is recognized by the School Education Deptt, Govt of Tripura and is also affiliated to the Tripura Board of Secondary Education. Every year Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt of India sanctions grant for 100 students. Cost of food, books and stationeries, uniform, sports materials, salary to teachers and staffs etc are borne by the Ministry. A 3000 litre capacity water filter has been constucted in Anurupa Academy to

solve drinking water problem of the students.

During this year (2022-2023), total no. of students admitted were 98 nos. In the Annual examination 2022, class wise number of strength and passed students are as follows:

Apart from teaching and learning in the school, students participated in various co curricular activities. Important days and occasions were observed in the School like, Birthday of Swami Vivekananda, Birthday of Netaji Subhas Ch Basu, Republic Day, International Language Day, Teachers Day, Annual Day of Anurupa Academy etc. The teachers and Students celebrated World Environment Day, Yoga Day, Saraswati Puja, On 26 November 2022, Constitution Day or Sambidhan Divas was celebrated in the













Academy. The students and teachers readout the preamble to the Constitution of India. Annual sports meet was held in the month of January 2023. The students participated in different cultural programme of the Samity. Parents teacher meetting was organised for review of the study and other metters in the school. The students were taken to newly inaugurated Science City in Agartala for Educational Tour. They were very much excited to see the models which they studied in their books only.

2. SWADHAR GREH FOR DESTITUTE WOMEN:(Sponsored by Min. of Women & Child Dev, Govt of India):-

In 90's, Central Social Welfare Board, New Delhi, sanctioned the Short Stay Home Project in favour of the Samity. Then the grant of the project was channeled through All India Women's Conference, New Delhi. The Home was named as AMA NI KHURI (MOTHERS LAP) in local tribal language. Destitute & deserted women, trafficked girls and women, unmarried mothers, sexually abused girls are sent to the Swadhar Greh by Police, Women's Commission, Court, Social Welfare Dept, Social Organisations etc for shelter.

During 2022-23, details of the inmates are as follows

Total no. of inmates admitted -61 nos Women - 49 nos Children - 12 nos Inmates shifted to other Homes -5 nos (1 child, 4 adults) Returned to family -31 nos Self employed -3 nos Marriage arranged by NGO - 1 nos.

The inmates have been provided with vocational training in Tailoring, Machiene Embroidery, Paper bag making, Hand Embroidery etc. Their products are sold locally and the wages are handed over to them. New dresses were provided to the ladies and children during Durga Puja and Bengali New year.

They celebrated various occasions like birthday and rice ceremony of children, Holi Utsav, Bengali New Years Day, Yoga Day, Makar Sankranti etc. The inmates were taken to Rabindra Kanan to enjoy a flower show. Monthly pocket money @ Rs 100/- for inmates and Rs 67/- for children are paid to them regularly.

Due to non receipt of grant from the Ministry of Women and Child Dev since last 2 years, the organization is facing constraint to continue regular activities.



3. RUNNING OF CRECHE CENTRE

Sponsored by Ministry of Women and child Development:-

For the children of working mothers,3 Creche centrer (one in tribal village at Lefunga and two centres in Tea garden at Kalachhara and Gopalnagar) are being looked after by the



Samity. In each centre 25 children (0-5+years) are selected through survey by the Creche workers. They are provided with nutritional food, medicine etc. Children of the centres are kept engaed in the centrs through different activities like clay modeling, drawing, collection of leaves to be acquainted with colour and shape. They also enjoy playing indoor and outdoor games etc.

The Organisation has constituted one Creche Management Committee which monitors the activities of the centres. One member of the Samity is given charge to look after the activities of the centres, She arranges supply of food materials, prepare reports and send to higher authorities.



4. JAN SHIKSHAN SANSTHAN (Sponsored by Ministry of Skill Dev Govt. of India):-

At the beginning, in 2004 this Project was sanctioned by the Ministry of HRD and later on it was handed over to the Ministry of Skill Dev. Govt of India. This project is meant for vocational training to Illiterate, Semi literate and Neo literate persons in West Tripura District. Upto March 2023, no. of beneficiaries undergone training in different vocational courses were 1799 nos in 90 batches. Beneficiaries were S.T-742 nos, S.C – 646 nos and Gen – 411nos. Total target was given 1800 nos, by the Ministry. Trainees were trained for different activities so that after training, they may start their income generation as — Asst Dress Maker, Beauty Care Asst, Asst Welder and Fabricator, Domestic Care Attendant, Helper to Electric Technician, Asst Fruits and Vegetable Processing, Asst Hand Embroidery, Asst Bamboo Craft, Asst Jute Craft, Asst Plumbing and Sanitary Works.etc.

Under Activity programme, the following were done - Observance of Republic Day, Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, Bhasha Dibas, Celebration of Constitution Day, Jana Jatiya





Gaurav Dibas, Convocation of JSS passouts, Celebration of National Unity Dibas, Plantation Drive, Swachchhata Pakhwara, Teachers Day and International Women's Day celebration, Yoga Day celebration., World Aids Day, Girl Child Day and Women's Day etc.

5. CHILDLINEAGARTALA(NODAL)

(Sponsored by Ministry of Women & Child Development):-

The Organisation is working as the NODAL Agency of Childline Agartala for Care & Protection of Children in crisis, since 2011. As the Nodal Organisation in West Tripura, Childline Agartala supervises the activities of Collab and Support Organisations and send Monthly report to CIF, KOLKATA. Sometimes Nodal Agency has to compile reports of all Childlines in the State and send to higher authority.

Awareness and other programmes organized by Childline Agartla was World Tobacco Day, World Environment Day, World Day Aginst Child Labour, Azadi ka Amri Mahotsav, AGP on Child Trafficking, CSD Progaram, Save girl Child, Birthday Celebration of Childline.



6. CHILDLINE KHOWAI (COLLAB) (Sponsored by Ministry of Women & Child Dev, GOI)

Since 2018, Childline Khowai (COLLAB) is working for the children, who require shelter, food, medical facility, educational support in Khowai District. The team members, who were selected from different parts of the District were given responsibility to find out children who are in need of shelter, health care, restoration and inform Khowai Child Welfare Committee for providing necessary assistance to the child.

MWCD has informed all the implementing organisations that Childline Project will continue upto August 2023 only and after that period it will be controlled by Govt Deptt. This year Childline Khowai has performed the following activities:-

- 1. Shelter 6 nos
- 2. Sponsorship 1 no
- 3. Protection from abuse-1 no
- 4. Others-1 no

7) OTHER PROGRAMMES OF THE SAMITY

- a) Republic Day was celebrated at Samity Headoffice, Anurupa Academy, JSS Office, Swadhar Greh by the Samity members, Teachers, JSS staffs, students, Inmates of Swadhar Greh etc. National was hoisted by Vice President of the samity. Patriotic songs were sung by the students of Anurupa Academy and the inmates of Swadhar Greh.
- b) Vocational Traning on Beautician Course & Tailoring was organised at Samity Headoffice for 30 nos educated unemployed women for self employment.
- C) Teachers Day was also observed on 5° Sept in the school, in which the life of Dr Sarbapalli Radhakrishnan was discussed. Smt Namita Chowdhury and Smt Jayasri Chakrabarty Banerjee, both retired teacher were felicitated on that occasion. The students prepared a Wall Magazine with their self written poems, notes amd memories.







- d) Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav was observed in all the units of the Samity. National Flag was Hoisted with great enthusiasm among the children in Creche Centres, Teachers and students of School, Inmates and staffs of Swadhar Greh, Head office of the Samity was decorated with colourful tuni bulbs.
- e) Our Organisation has been associated with 'Aaharan', a Learning App for students of class IX and X under TBSE schools. Through this App, students can be benefitted to avail coaching in all subjects in Bengali and Kok borok language.
- f) An Awarness program on Prevention of Breast Cancer was organised. The program was



sponsered by ILS Hospital Agartala. Dr. L P Bhaskar Bhuvan, Medical Oncologist spoke eleborately on this topic and our members also participated in discussion.





- g) On 10° Sept 2022, Birthday of Lt. Anurupa Mukharjee and Annual Prize distribution of Anurupa Academy was observed in a grand manner, in which all the Samity members, staffs of all Project of the Samity participated. The pass out students of the Academy, who secured 1° Div in Madhyamik Board Examination and students who secured 1°,2° and 3° position in class examinations were also given prizes. The students performed in cultural programme.
- h) General meeting of the Samity was held on 18 th December 2022, in which Physical and Financial Reports were read out by Secretary and Treasurer and approved by the General members. Reports of the Incharges of Sub Committees of different Projects were read out and discussed.
- i) Women's Day was observed in the main office of the Samity. In the programme Smt Chandra Roy, Editor, Tripura Bhabisyat, a daity news paper and Smt Manisha Paul owner of Bhubaneswari TV Channel were faliciteted. In that program, students of Anurupa Academy performed culcurel activies.
- j) Marriage of one inmate of Swadhar Greh, namely Smt Priya Paul, was arranged by the Organisation. All the members, staffs of the Samity and other kind hearted people, donated in cash and kind for the marriage. Now she is settled with her in laws.
- k) World Envoironment Day was observed by the Samity with various activities like Awareness about cleanlines and planting of saplings for safe Envoironment at lake




